PEMS GUIDE FOR PRESENTERS

- **Preparation**: Choose a publication in hybrid PET/MR imaging. The publication must be recent (**within two year**) and **related to the presenter's current or future work** at Lawson's PET/MR;
- **Submission**: Please submit your journal article via email to Lucas Narciso (lnarciso@uwo.ca) **no later than two weeks prior to your scheduled presentation**. The paper will be available to the other members no later than one week prior to the scheduled presentation;
- **Presentation***: Present a 15 minutes overview of the chosen publication. Please arrive 5 minutes before the scheduled time for arrangements;
- **Discussion***: The presentation is followed by up to 30 minutes of lively discussion on the work described in the publication.

* When two presenters are scheduled to present in the same day, both speakers will have 15 minutes to present and 15 minutes for discussion.

For pre-conference PeMS, each attendee will have ~10 min to present their original work for oral/poster presentation followed by 5 minutes Q/A or discussion by the group.
